These ladies have been faithful, loyal employees and servants through these years. It would be a great honor for us and for them if you are able to be present.

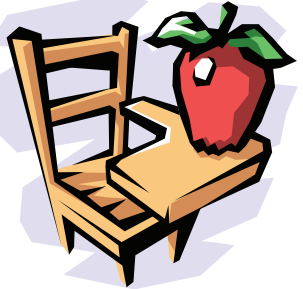
